Price Agreement Selection Process

(1) Consultants for pPrice aAgreements must be selected, and the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department (OPRD) must obtain aArchitectural, eEngineering, and lLand sSurveying and rRelated sServices by selecting a cConsultant or cConsultants in the following manner:-

(a) When OPRD selects more than one cConsultant in accordance with under the pPrice aAgreement sSolicitation process under OAR 137-048-0130(1), OPRD must identify objective criteria in the sSolicitation dDocument and the pPrice aAgreement to be used in assigning particular aArchitectural, eEngineering and lLand sSurveying and or rRelated sServices to the most qualified consultant.

(2b) Design-Build cContracts involve the provision of both design and construction services for pPublic iImprovements under one cContract. Under most circumstances, Design-Build cContracts are mMixed cContracts with the predominate purpose of the cContract involving construction of the pPublic iImprovement. If the predominate purpose of the cContract is to obtain aArchitectural, eEngineering, and lLand sSurveying and rRelated aServices, selection may proceed under this division and shall not be considered a Design-Build project.
